

# DIY Glass Luminary

Create a beautiful glass luminary jar with just a few materials



## Supplies provided:

- A mason jar
- Mod Podge
- Foam brush
- Blue and green tissue paper
- Battery-operated tea light



**No materials are needed from home**

## Directions:

1. Using the foam brush, spread a thin layer of Mod Podge on one side of the jar from top to bottom avoiding the area where the top will screw on.
2. Working quickly before the Mod Podge dries, place tissue paper pieces over the area overlapping the edges to cover the glass surface.
3. Gently apply another thin coat of Mod Podge over the applied tissue paper. This step must be done very delicately so that you don't brush off or wrinkle the tissue paper. If wrinkling does occur, gently move the brush in the opposite direction to clear the wrinkle.
4. Continue steps 1-3 until the entire jar is covered with tissue paper squares and has a thin coat of Mod Podge over it.
5. Allow jar to completely dry (about an hour).
6. Slide the switch on the bottom of the tea light to the on position, place inside the jar and enjoy your glass luminary!
