

Wildflower Seed Bomb

Create a wildflower seed bomb for your garden



Supplies provided:

- Blue and green construction paper
- Wildflower seeds
- Cheesecloth

Items needed from home

- Water
- A cup and bowl
- Rubber bands



Directions:

1. Rip the blue and green construction paper into small pieces and put in a bowl.
2. Pour water over the paper until it is covered. Let paper soak for 20 minutes.
3. Process water and paper in a food processor (or hand pick) until well blended.
4. Drape a square of cheesecloth over a cup and secure with a rubber band.
5. Place half of the paper mixture on top of the cheesecloth and let drain for a minute. Sprinkle some wildflower seeds on top.
6. Place the remaining paper mixture on top of the seeds and let mixture drain again for a minute.
7. Remove rubber band, lift the cheesecloth and squeeze tightly to drain the remaining water. Carefully remove and discard the cheesecloth.
8. Roll/squeeze the seed bomb in your hands until it is (mostly) a round ball (may look lumpy!).
9. Let the seed bomb dry for several hours and then plant it where you desire.
10. If conditions are dry, water your planted seed bomb regularly and enjoy watching the flowers bloom!
