

# Candy Corn Centerpiece



## **Candy that's larger than life!**

Decorate your table with a gigantic candy corn that looks good enough to eat.

*Kit includes supplies for one centerpiece.*

## Candy Corn Centerpiece

### Supplies:

#### Included:

- Yellow yarn
- White yarn
- Orange yarn
- Styrofoam cone

#### Not Included:

- Glue (hot glue recommended)

### Instructions:

1. Add a small dab of glue to the middle of the cone's base. Attach one end of the yellow yarn, as in **Fig. 1**.
2. Coil the yarn in a spiral, adding glue as necessary, (**Fig. 2**), until you've covered the entire base (**Fig. 3**).
3. Continue to wrap the yellow yarn around the bottom third of the cone (**Fig. 4**). No need to be exact; but do take care to cover any spots where the Styrofoam is showing.
4. When all the yellow yarn is wrapped, leave about an inch (1") of tail, as in **Fig. 5**.
5. Begin wrapping the orange yarn around the middle third of the cone; take care to wrap over both the tail of yellow yarn, and the end of the orange yarn several times (**Fig. 6**).
6. When all the orange yarn is wrapped, leave about an inch (1") of tail, as in **Fig. 7**.
7. Begin wrapping the white yarn around the top third of the cone; take care to wrap over both the tail of the orange yarn, and the end of the white yarn several times (**Fig. 8**).
8. Wrap the white yarn until about one foot (1') of yarn remains. Add a drop of glue to the top of the cone. Coil the yarn in a spiral, adding glue as necessary until you've covered the top of the cone, as in **Fig. 9**.
