

# Snowflake Brooch



**We're in for six more weeks of winter!**

Decorate your bulky winter coats and scarves with a delicate and beautiful snowflake brooch.

*Kit includes supplies for one brooch*

## Snowflake Brooch

### Supplies:

#### Included:

- White felt approximately three by four inches (3"x4")
- Eight (8) seed beads
- Eight (8) bugle (rod) beads
- One (1) bead approximately the size of a pony bead
- One (1) pin back
- Pattern

#### Not Included:

- Felt tip / permanent marker
- Scissors
- Glue (hot glue recommended)



### Instructions:

1. Using scissors, cut out the template (Fig. 1).
2. Trace the template eight (8) times onto the felt with a felt tip or permanent marker (Fig. 2).
3. Cut out the traced snowflake petals on the inside of the black lines (Fig. 3).
4. Take one (1) petal in your hand. Place a small dot of glue on the narrow end of the petal as seen in Fig. 4.
5. Fold the petal in half, pinching the narrow end to secure the glue (Fig. 5). Keep pinching until the glue has dried.
6. Glue one (1) bugle bead running lengthwise in the middle of a petal (Fig. 6).
7. Glue one (1) seed bead above the bugle bead from the previous step at the top of a petal (Fig. 7).
8. Repeat steps four through seven (4-7) for the remaining petals.
9. Holding one (1) petal, add a thin strip of glue to the right hand side as in Fig. 8.
10. Working quickly, touch the left side of a second petal to the glue as in Fig. 9. Hold tightly until the glue has dried.

11. Repeat steps nine through ten (9-10) until all the petals are glue together as in Fig. 10.
12. Bend the petals in a circle to so the left edge of the first petal and the right edge of the last petal are touching as in Fig. 11. Secure with a thin strip of glue and let dry completely.
13. Add a drop of glue to the center of the circle of petals, where the tips touch (Fig. 12).
14. Working quickly, add a bead to the center of the snowflake to cover the glue and the tips of the petals (Fig. 13). Let dry completely.
15. Turn the snowflake over. Add a strip of glue to the pin back. Glue the pin back to the center of the snowflake as in Fig. 14. Let dry completely.




